The musical trio Elixir will entertain with American music of the 1800s on Sunday during Trumbull County's upcoming Heritage Festival Weekend (Saturday, Sept. 20 and Sunday, Sept. 21.)

Elixir will offer three free performances: 1 p.m., 2:15 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. at the Warren Community Amphitheatre, 303 Mahoning Avenue in downtown Warren.

This talented trio performs traditional music (and their own compositions) in 1800s-period costume. In addition to the music, they share histories of the tunes and their composers. Elixir redefines the music of our ancestors and brings it to life for today's audiences.
